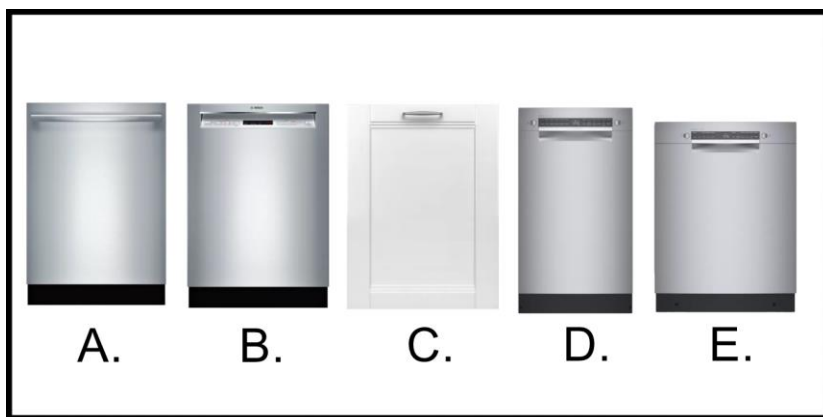


101 Dishwasher

Dishwashers seem like the easiest thing to choose when it comes to appliances in your kitchen, but you actually have many choices in design and how they work.

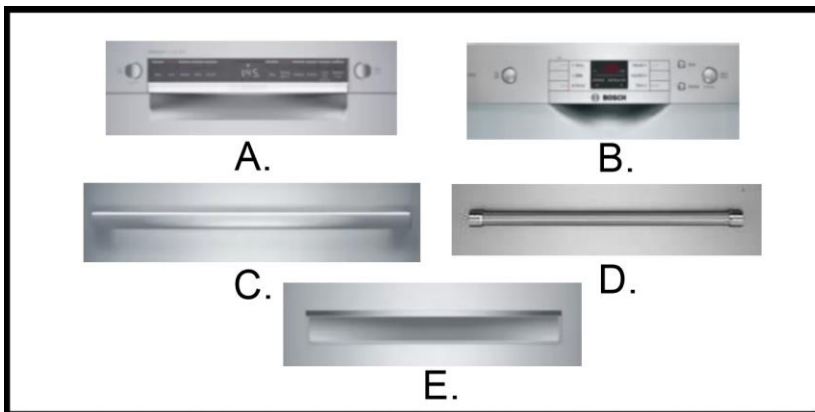
Types of Dishwashers:

- A. Top-Control
- B. Front Control
- C. Panel Ready
- D. 18" Width
- E. ADA Height



Dishwasher Handle Styles:

- A. Recessed Handle
- B. Scoop Handle
- C. Bar Handle
- D. Pro Style Bar Handle
- E. Pocket Handle



Dishwasher Features (Vary by Brand):

- Stainless-Steel Interior – Condensation will adhere to the stainless-steel surface, effectively pulling the moisture from the drying dishes, leaving them dryer than a plastic interior would.
- 3rd Rack – Usually a slim rack at the top of your dishwasher, a 3rd rack frees up space normally taken up by larger utensils in other parts of your dishwasher, increasing capacity.
- Decibels – To get the quietest dishwasher, aim for the lowest decibel rating you can afford. Anything under 44 decibels is considered a quiet dishwasher.
