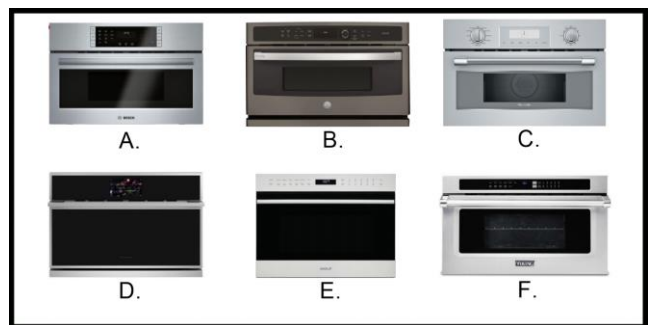


# Speed Oven

A speed oven, while also being a microwave, has some differences. It is the best of all worlds.

## Features of Speed Ovens:

- Microwave Speed – At its heart, a speed oven is a microwave, however, it has additional features that make it superior in every way.
- Additional Heat – There will be some form of additional heat within a speed oven. For example, GE uses what they call Advantium, which is halogen lights which brown and crisp up food. Another form is broiler elements, like Bosch. This also gives your food that crispness and browning that you cannot get from a basic microwave.
- Convection – Speed ovens will all have convection. This creates an even, faster cook versus traditional baking.
- Size – Widths will be 24”, 27” or 30”. As a general rule, a speed oven will have a smaller interior cavity than other wall ovens.
- Broiling – All speed ovens will have broiling capabilities from an upper element or halogen lighting.

## Options:

- Speed ovens are available as a separate built-in appliance, and also as the top portion of a double wall oven insert.
